**GREEN MOUNTAIN CARE BOARD ANNOUNCES VERMONT HEALTH CONNECT RATE HEARINGS**

The Green Mountain Care Board (GMCB) will hold hearings open to the public concerning the proposed 2019 Vermont Health Connect insurance rates on Monday, July 23<sup>rd</sup> (Blue Cross Blue Shield of Vermont) in Room 10 and Tuesday, July 24<sup>th</sup> (MVP Health Plan, Inc.) in Room 11 of the Vermont State House beginning at 9:00 a.m. each morning.
