DECISION & ORDER ON MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

On July 1, 2014, the Green Mountain Care Board issued its decisions in the above-captioned rate review proceedings. On July 11, 2014, Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Vermont and The Vermont Health Plan, LLC (collectively, BCBSVT) filed a motion for reconsideration. The Office of the Health Care Advocate (HCA) filed a response to the motion on July 16, 2014.

BCBSVT's motion seeks reconsideration of the Board's decision to reduce the companies' proposed 2.0% contributions to surplus for insured large groups and 0.5% for costplus groups to 0.5% and 0.25%, respectively. BCBSVT asks that the Board revise its decisions and approve the contributions to surplus as proposed. Despite initially supporting a reduction of the large group reserves from 2.0% to 1.0%, the HCA now opposes BCBSVT's motion and asks that the Board sustain its initial decision.

Having reviewed the motion and the response, the Board now grants the motion in part and approves a 1.0% contribution to surplus for insured large groups and 0.25% for the cost plus groups. By making this change, we conform our decision to the opinion and recommendation of our actuary, Lewis & Ellis, who reviewed the filing and based its recommendation on the lack of adequate support for the full 2.0% requested. This result is firmly supported by the record and continues to strike an appropriate balance between providing an adequate buffer for the companies' solvency and creating rates that are affordable for the consumer.

ORDER

For the reasons discussed above, the Board revises its order of July 1, 2014 in the two above-captioned dockets by approving a contribution to surplus of 1.0% for insured large groups, and 0.25% for cost plus groups. The Board's July 1, 2014 decision stands in all other respects.
