The Green Mountain Care Board hereby requests that Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Vermont (BCBSVT) provide the following information to assist with the Board's review of the above-referenced filings. Please provide responses by August 5, 2024.

1. For BCBSVT's 10 most common mental health CPT codes:
 - a. Provide BCBSVT's reimbursement for mental health visits in VT and bordering locations.
 - b. Provide a comparison of BCBSVT's reimbursement to other payers' reimbursement in VT and bordering locations. Provide the source of the information used for the comparison.
2. It appears that BCBSVT's quantification of the impacts of Act 111 focused solely on claims increases due to the elimination of savings from the programs described on Exhibit 8, page 14. Describe any administrative costs of these programs, including staff costs and any third-party vendors, that would be eliminated:
 - a. Under Act 111 as originally enacted.
 - b. Under Act 111, as amended by Act 185.
